

## VOLUNTEER CADET LEADER



### THE ROLE:

- >> To manage, supervise and lead cadet sessions
- >> To ensure the on-going welfare and safeguarding of cadets
- >> To be a positive role model for young persons
- >> To build bridges between the police and community

### WHAT YOU GET:

- >> You will get 50% of your time back as TOIL
- >> You will be issued a Cadet Leader uniform
- >> You will get the opportunity to develop new skills and experiences
- >> PCSOs can assist units during duty time

WMP Cadets were reintroduced in September 2017 as part of Police & Crime Commissioner David Jamieson's plan to develop and sustain positive relationships between the police and the young people of the West Midlands. The scheme now operates units at schools in Birmingham, Coventry, Dudley, Sandwell, Solihull, Walsall, and Wolverhampton.

### WHAT IS IT?

Cadets will take part in volunteer activities with their communities, represent WMP at public-facing events, engage with their Neighbourhood Policing Teams, learn about policing from the Volunteer Police Cadets manual, go on trips to WMP departments, hear from specialist speakers, play sports, run teambuilding and leadership exercises – and more!

### WHAT WE NEED

We need people from all over the force and all different roles, whether police Officer, PCSO, special or staff member.

Don't worry if you have no previous experience, or you're on a shift pattern with variable availability. If you want to help, you can!

There is no upper age limit, and no minimum physical fitness requirement. Volunteers with disabilities or medical restrictions are welcome.

You will be provided excellent opportunities for personal and professional development, whether you are seeking promotion or just looking to expand your skills and experiences.

You will be making a positive impact in the lives of young people from a diverse range of backgrounds.
