Sixth form pupils MUST present a corporate image and set an example to the rest of the school.

Sixth Form Uniform	Uniform
All	Smart business style suit (similar coloured jackets and skirt/trousers do not constitute a
	suit)
	Suit jackets mus t be worn at all times
	Outdoor coats and jackets should be smart and not worn in the school building
	No hoodies (including leavers' or sports/swim squad), no track suit tops or casual jackets are to be worn over or under suits
Female Uniform	Ladies may wear tailored style skirt suits or shift dress suit (with blouse underneath) instead of tailored trouser suit
	The suit skirt length must be worn on the knee or longer
	Tight or elasticated skirts and trousers are too casual and not permitted
	A shirt or blouse with a proper collar must be worn underneath suits and shift dresses
	Ladies may wear tights that are plain and sober colours
	Cardigans or casual jackets must not be worn instead of suit jackets
	No polo neck jumpers allowed
Male Uniform	Shirts must remain tucked in at all times
	Ties are to be worn with the top button of the shirt done up. Please buy shirts that allow this
	to be done comfortably
	Shirts with a proper collar must be worn underneath suits
	Cardigans or casual jackets must not be worn instead of suit jackets
11.1.	V-neck jumpers may be worn over a shirt and tie, not crew neck or sweatshirt material
Hair	Facial piercings and eccentric hairstyles and colours are not suitable e.g. closely shaved or tram lines
	Hair should be no longer than collar length on males and neat on females
	Facial hair is not desirable. Males should be clean shaven unless reflecting religious custom
Jewellery	Jewellery should be discreet and large hoop earrings are inappropriate
	A small plain pair of stud earrings are permissible for boys
Makeup	Makeup should be discreet and natural looking with no extremes of style
	No acrylics or false nails are permitted
PE Kit	Nail varnish should be natural or subdued in colour with no adornments or patterns School PE reversible t-shirt
PE NIL	School PE reversible t-shift School PE tracksuit bottoms

Shoes

Shoes must be formal, black in colour and polishable. No boots or Doctor Martens are to be worn at school and any heels should remain low, stilettos are not permitted. Trainers/trainer style shoes are not acceptable footwear.

Head coverings

All religious head coverings must be a plain, dark colour with no adornments or embellishments.

Coats

Coats should be a dark colour, navy blue, royal blue or black and may not have any large logos or brands visible. Students are expected to take off their coats when inside the school building.

Headphones

Sixth Formers should also bring their own wired headphones for use in computing lessons. They must not be worn outside of lessons.
