Uniform guidance

Please ensure that **all items of uniform are clearly labelled** with your child's name; this is very important as we cannot take responsibility for unnamed items.

School uniform must be worn at all times on the journey to and from school and throughout the school day. Failure to adhere to school's policy will result in sanctions in line with the school's behaviour policy.

PE Kit guidance

- Tracksuit bottoms must be worn around the school site on PE days. Shorts, skorts or leggings must be worn underneath the tracksuit bottoms. Tracksuits may be removed for PE activities.
- Leggings are an optional item worn in place of skorts or shorts. Pupils may only wear the school branded leggings purchased from the school supplier. Tracksuits must be worn over leggings around the school site.
- Any items of PE kit not purchased from the school supplier must be plain with no branded logos (e.g. nike, adidas etc.).
- Recommended local High Street suppliers for non-branded items are Next, Tesco, Sainsbury's, Asda or Marks & Spencer.
- Swimming trunks/shorts should be above the knee. Swimsuits must be one-piece, plain with no frills or adornments. Appropriate adjustments to swimwear may be made for religious observation. Please discuss this with the school for further information. Discreet logos are acceptable on swimwear.
- Legacy PE kits can be worn until end of life with the exception of the school hoodie which may only be worn until the end of July 2026.

Shoes

Shoes must be formal, black in colour and polishable. No boots are to be worn at school (Except when in CCF uniform) and any heels should remain low, stilettos are not permitted. Trainers/trainer style shoes are not acceptable footwear when in full school uniform.

Jewellery

No jewellery must be worn to school other than simple plain, gold or silver stud earrings for girls (one per ear) but no other body piercings. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or have other body piercings. Wearing of a watch is permitted.

Hairstyles

Hair must be kept neat and tidy, at all times. Pupils must not dye hair unnatural colours. Shoulder length hair or longer, must be tied back for PE/Games and within a laboratory. Braiding should be a natural colour and all hair accessories must be plain black, dark brown or navy blue only. Shaved lines or extremes of style are not permitted, no shorter than a grade 2 haircut is permitted.

Halo Code

Our school champions the right of staff and students to embrace all Afro-hairstyles. We acknowledge that Afro-textured hair is an important part of our Black staff and students' racial, ethnic, cultural, and religious identities, and requires specific styling for hair health and maintenance. We welcome Afro-textured hair worn in all styles including, but not limited to, afros, locs, twists, braids, cornrows, fades, hair straightened through the application of heat or chemicals, weaves, wigs, headscarves, and wraps. At this school, we recognise and celebrate our staff and students' identities. We are a community built on an ethos of equality and respect where hair texture and style have no bearing on anyone's ability to succeed. Note that Hair wraps and scarves must be of a suitable muted colour (preferably black or blue) to match where possible the school uniform. Patterned or bright wraps and scarves are not permitted.

Make up

Make-up should be discreet in colour; false eye lashes are not permitted. No acrylics, false nails or nail varnish should be worn at school. Nail length should be kept short and tidy.

School coats

Coats should be a dark colour, navy blue, royal blue or black and may not have any large logos or brands visible. Pupils are expected to take off their coats when inside the school building.

Headphones

Pupils should also bring their own wired headphones for use in computing lessons. They must not be worn outside of lessons.

Head Coverings

Hats, scarves and gloves must be a plain dark colour such as navy blue, royal blue or black. All religious head coverings must be plain navy blue, royal blue or black colour only, no adornments or embellishments. During the Summer, sun hats and caps can be worn however they must be plain navy, royal blue or black in colour and removed indoors.

Summary

We are very proud of the school uniform, and it forms a key part of our school identity. Failure to follow the schools' uniform policy and guidance may result in your child being withdrawn from representing the school at sporting fixtures or attending school trips.
