We are excited to announce that we have planned a trip open to those students from Year 7 to Year 13 taking Music GCSE/BTEC, Drama, in School Production and our Music Prefects.

We have arranged a school trip to London to see the world-renowned musical **Les Miserables** in the West End. This powerful and moving production, featuring unforgettable music and storytelling, is one of the most celebrated musicals of all time and promises to be an inspiring live theatre experience for our students.

Prior to the performance, students will have some supervised free time to visit **Covent Garden**, where they will be able to explore the market area and soak up the vibrant atmosphere of the West End.

The cost of the trip is **£70 per student**, which includes the theatre ticket and travel. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and may bring a payment card for any purchases they wish to make.

Payment Schedule:
